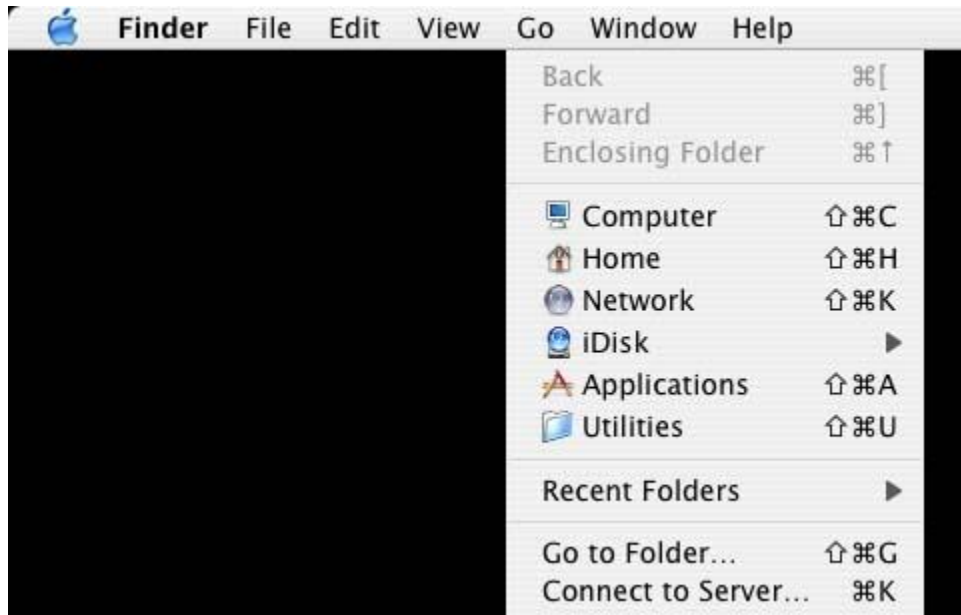


## Accessing DICOM Data from MAC Computers

\*\*\*If you are outside of the Brain Mapping Center building you will need to connect to BMC via VPN

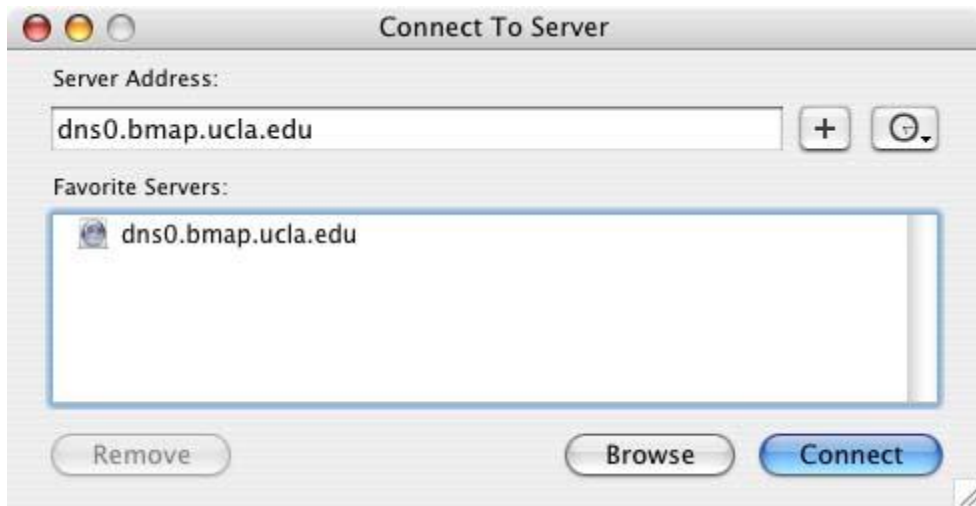
1. From the Finder's "Go" Menu, choose "Connect to Server..."



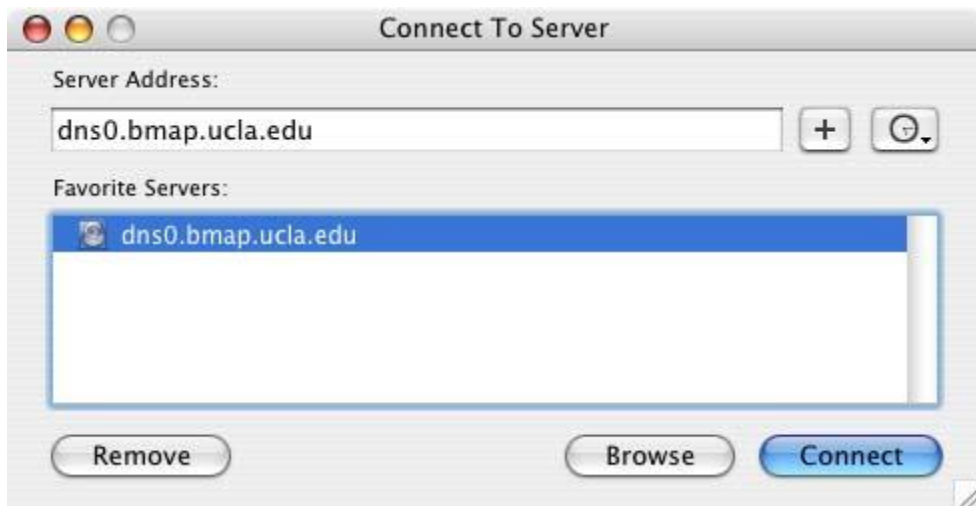
2. Enter "dns0.bmap.ucla.edu" in the Server Address field



3. For future convenience, press the "+" button so that the server will be added to your "Favorites"



This will allow you to just click on the server to automatically enter the name



4. Press the "Connect" button



5. If you want the password to be completed automatically in the future, press the "Options" button, check the "Add Password to Keychain" button, and press "OK"



6. Press the "Connect" button on the "Connect to file server dns0 as:" dialog"
7. For data acquired before April 1, 2008, select "dicom" as the volume that you wish to mount. For data acquired on or after April 1, 2008, select "dicom2" as

the volume that you wish to mount. Press the "OK" button



8. Click on the dicom icon in a Finder window to display the files in the directory you would like to browse. Most of the files will have red minus signs indicating that you cannot access them because they belong to other people. You will be able to access the folder of any group to which you belong. DICOM data will be stored according to the group designated on the scanner prior to transfer.
