

How to access non-dicom data (i.e. task files and raw image data)

Windows

1. Go to the file folder > click “This PC”
2. Select 3 dots on the toolbar and choose “Map network drive”
3. When the box pops up choose an available drive, Z drive is the default, if it is being used choose the next available letter (i.e. Y, X, W etc). Letter doesn’t matter.
4. Under “Folder” type \\10.2.0.98\MRIFILE or choose from the dropdown if this isn’t your first time mapping the drive
5. Click on “Connect using different credentials” then click finish
6. Log in with your NRB credentials (don’t forget the \bmap) before your name
 - bmap\username
 - Password
7. Choose your group folder

Mac

1. On top tool bar click Go/connect to server
2. Put in 10.2.0.98 and connect
3. Enter NRB logon credentials when prompted
4. Go to MRIFILE
5. Choose your group folder
